

Guidelines for advancement to the national level of the TSA VEX Robotics Competition

The national level of the TSA VEX Robotics Competition will be held at the 2012 national TSA conference in Nashville, Tennessee. The conference dates are June 21-25.

The number of teams participating in the TSA VEX Robotics Competition championship event held during the national TSA conference is limited to one hundred (100) teams, with up to seven (7) teams allowed per state.*

Each participating TSA chapter may have a maximum of two (2) teams compete in the VEX event at the national TSA conference. Teams qualify to advance to the national TSA VEX Robotics Competition championship event based on the priority below.

1. TSA teams that win the tournament championship at an official VEX Robotics Competition (VRC) held at a state TSA conference; tournament finalists are waitlisted and can register for any national TSA conference championship spots that are open as of May 14, 2012
2. TSA teams that win the tournament championship at an official VRC in their state, if their state has no state TSA conference
3. TSA teams that win the Excellence Award at any official VRC tournament in their state

*Should space be available after all eligible TSA teams (championship winning teams and waitlisted teams) from a state have registered for the national TSA conference event, then non-TSA teams [limit of one (1) team per school] may register.
