Since 2003, members of the Technology Student Association (TSA) have made a difference in the fight against cancer. TSA members donate their time and raise valuable funds to help save lives from cancer. One of the most effective ways TSA members can continue to help is to participate in the American Cancer Society Relay For Life.

What is Relay For Life?

Relay For Life is the signature activity of the American Cancer Society, and it is a time to celebrate, remember, and fight back against cancer. Teams of people camp out at a local high school, park, or fairground and take turns walking or running around a track or path. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event. Because cancer never sleeps, Relays are overnight events up to 24 hours long.

Relay For Life brings together millions of people to raise much needed funds and awareness to help save lives and create a world with less cancer and more birthdays.

Why Relay?

Relay For Life is often described as a life-changing event. Each year, more than 3.5 million people in more than 5,000 communities nationwide gather to celebrate the lives of people who have battled cancer, remember loved ones lost, and fight back against a disease that takes too much. By providing the opportunity to take action against cancer, Relay For Life unites communities and inspires hope that cancer will be eliminated.



Cancer survivors are at the heart of Relay For Life. The event brings families, friends, coworkers, and communities together to celebrate victory over cancer and to support those still battling the disease. Each Relay event opens with an inspirational Survivors Lap, which symbolizes the steps we are taking toward hope and healing.

Caregivers are also recognized and celebrated at Relay For Life. These individuals give their time, love, and support to friends, family, and neighbors who face cancer. At Relay, people understand the frustrations and joys of being a caregiver. There is peace of mind in knowing that together we can face the many challenges cancer poses.
