

TSA Officer Symbols

Below is general information regarding the responsibilities for each TSA office and the corresponding symbol for that office. President – The Gavel

The symbol of this office is the gavel. It is the duty of the president to preside at all regular and special meetings and to promote cooperation in carrying out the activities and work of our organization.

Vice President – The Star

The symbol of this office is a star. It is the duty of the vice president to see that there is always a strong membership, a good work program and to be alert to the welfare of our association.

Secretary - The Pen

The symbol of this office is the pen. It is the responsibility of the secretary to keep accurate and proper records of all business and correspondence of our association.

Treasurer – The Balanced Budget

The symbol of this office is the balanced budget. It is the duty of the treasurer to keep accurate records of all funds and see that our financial obligations are met promptly.

Reporter – The Beacon Tower

The symbol of this office is the beacon tower. It is the duty of the reporter to see that our school, community and national association have a complete report of our organization's activities.

Sergeant-at-Arms – The Hearty Handshake

The symbol of this office is the hearty handshake. It is the responsibility of the sergeant-at-arms to see that the assembly is comfortable and properly welcomed. It is also their duty to serve as doorkeeper for this organization.
